Jordan ABC Ballroom, Student Union Building on the Boise State University campus.

The Boise Law School Fair will be held in the Boise State University, Student Union Building (SUB), Jordan ABC Ballroom on Thursday, October 31, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. The Jordan ABC Ballroom is on the 2nd floor of the SUB, please see [Campus Map](#).

Early Set-Up - The Jordan ABC Ballroom will be open at 9:00 a.m. for you to begin setting up your table. The SUB requests that you please use only art putty to hang materials on painted surfaces, use Velcro on cloth walls.

DRIVING INFORMATION

Boise State University is less than 10 minutes from the airport, which is served by several major airlines including Alaska, American, Delta, Southwest, and United.

The university is in Boise's vibrant downtown, between Broadway Avenue and Capitol Boulevard, near Interstate 84. The Broadway and Vista exits are closest to campus.

If you exit on Broadway you will continue on that street until University Drive (you will see the Stadium on the corner, approx. 10-minute drive).

Take a left on University Drive and follow it until Lincoln Ave (the SUB will be on your right and the parking garage on your left). Take a left on Lincoln Ave and turn left into the parking garage.

If you are coming from Vista (if you rent a car at the airport you will exit onto Vista) you will follow Vista until it turns into Capitol Blvd just past the old train depot. Keep right.

You will then take a right on University Drive and follow it until you see the SUB on your left and the parking garage directly ahead of you. (Approx. 10 minutes)

PARKING

Day of Event Parking - Parking will be in the Lincoln Parking Garage, directly across from the Student Union

Downtown Boise is compact and pedestrian-friendly, with many restaurants along the [Eighth Street Promenade](#).

Food on Campus

We will have coffee, tea, and water in the Jordan Ballroom beginning at 9:00 a.m. the morning of October 31st. We will provide lunch after the Fair (beginning at approximately 12:30 p.m.) Please let us know at least two weeks in advance if you have any dietary restrictions.

If you would like additional food or caffeine, Starbucks, Chick-fil-A, Tree City Juice & Smoothie Cafe, and other dining options are on the first floor of the SUB, along with a small [bowling alley](#).

Restrooms

Restrooms are located to the left as you exit the Jordan Ballroom.

Boise State Bookstore

The bookstore is located on the first floor of the SUB if you need any miscellaneous supplies.

Blue Turf

There will be an opportunity immediately after the Fair to see Boise State's famous [Blue Turf](#) and take selfies. Go Broncos!

Boise River Greenbelt

The [Boise River Greenbelt](#) is a lovely place for a relaxing walk and occasionally includes views of the giraffes in Zoo Boise.
